Community Impact

Community Impact Statistics

Food Access

\$29 will feed 7 people living in areas and situations without access to grocery stores for fresh foods.

We fed 12,029 people through mobile food programs*

Social and Emotional Learning

\$73 will provide 10 students with the resources necessary to enhance skills in social, ethical, emotional, physical, and cognitive competencies.

We worked with 3,003 students*

Abuse and Neglect

\$187 will support 14 people experiencing domestic violence, abuse and neglect, including seniors and children, with interventions, resources, support, and healing.
